## Boutique Store

Birdhichand Ghanshyamdas recently opened a sprawling 1800 sq ft store located in South Delhi. Featuring a scrumptious smörgasbord of the fine art of jewellery and lavish architecture, the new store looks like a whimsical museum. The label's second standalone boutique in the country and first in the Indian capital, exudes a gentle fusion of British Colonial style and Rajasthan's architecture typified by custom-made French-styled furniture, the extensive use of multiple kinds of wood, and an ethereal celebration of pastel silhouettes. Balmy colours, finely curated antiques and a flamboyant display of bespoke jewellery designs reflect the brand's fondness for an art-filled extravagance.

The summer show 'Everything is Black and White' is a radical new look at what happens when artists cast aside the colour spectrum and focus on the visual power of black, white, and everything in between. Black and white or the monochrome painting concept developed during the 20th century. Depicting a sheer timeless medium, such paintings dramatically bring to fore the stupendous combination of contrast, texture, line and effect. The monochrome often communicates spiritual purity; by choosing one colour, artists could explore the tranquillity of total abstraction.
